The additional event organisers are:

Hunter Schools MTB - is a coaching and events business that has a focus on junior mountain bike racing and high-performance mountain bike athlete development. Timing and event management will be managed by this business.

Hunter Christian School - has been recognised as a School of Excellence and has gained this recognition through coaching and running junior mountain bike events. 2023 will be an extension of this program as the school will be supporting the NSW School Mountain Bike Series with Cert III Sports Coaching VET students and staff.

Why sponsor mountain bike events?

Mountain Biking is growing in popularity as a sport that caters for all ages and ability levels. Businesses associated with this event align themselves with the ideals of being fit, healthy and caring for the environment. They show support of junior sport and development of this sport at grass roots through NSW.



What is the "naming rights sponsor" NSW Schools Mountain Bike Series?

2023 will be the first year there will be an NSW Schools Mountain Bike Series on the Auscycling website. The series will consist of 6 events which includes the NSW School Mountain Bike Championships which will be held at Glenrock, NSW. The event is open to all school aged riders who will each receive complementary Auscycling medical insurance for the event. Event Information and registration will be accessed via the Auscycling website to create a central location for information.

This school only mountain bike series combines both XCO (Olympic distance racing) with the ever popular and potentially more fun Gravity Enduro style racing. This means riders at each of these events will have the opportunity to race in both competitions which will increase rider attendance and spectator appeal.

The NSW Schools Mountain Bike Series is being run the day before the One Contract Property MTB series. This adds value to families travelling for the event as riders will have the potential for 3 days of racing. Friday with the school only event, Saturday with a 2hr or 5hr club run event and Sunday will be a Gravity Enduro run by White Lightning Events.

How many people will attend the events?

It Is anticipated the first rounds of the series will attract 200-300 riders and 150-200 spectators and volunteers. The championship event will have well over 500 riders and 300-400 spectators and volunteers.

Race Categories and Length

Students will be able to race in gender divisions in the following categories:

Primary

- U7's
- U9's
- U11's
- U13's

Secondary

- U15's
- U17's
- U19's



The course length will vary according to age group and will be up to 4km. Riders will need to complete a set number of laps which will be based on the Auscycling junior guidelines per age group. The chosen track has been selected to allow riders to experience tracks that are super fun and safe enough that all riders can experience success.

Sponsor Benefits

The obligations of the clubs supporting this series is to contact the local media with the aim of having television, radio and local newspapers involved in promoting their event. Outside of local media for each Individual event, there will be social media through the local club and Hunter Schools MTB.

Sponsorship Opportunities
